

Safe Nest Statistics for 2005

SHELTER SERVICES

Provided 22,679 bednights of emergency shelter and related services for 1,355 domestic violence victims (662 women and 693 children).

COUNSELING OFFICES

Provided 20,895 therapy sessions for 2,207 individuals experiencing domestic violence problems (13,912 batterer's treatment, 6,082 victim and 898 child and adolescent sessions).

PROTECTION ORDER OFFICE

Assisted 9,518 victims seeking temporary protection orders and extended orders at Family Court (another 1,934 emergency protection orders were processed through the Safe Nest hotline).

HOTLINE SERVICES

Provided hotline counseling to 32,518 crisis callers, including 1,934 victims needing emergency protection orders processed by phone (provided 46,894 referrals to callers).

CRISIS RESPONSE IN THE FIELD

Crisis Response Teams and advocate staff assisted 221 victims at police stations. Court advocates assisted 721 victims and children with court preparation, court accompaniment and other advocate services.

COMMUNITY EDUCATION

Provided dating violence prevention and conflict resolution classes to 18,454 youth; skill training for over 4,021 professionals, community education for 3,918 individuals and public awareness education for over 10,000 individuals. Over 58,000 educational materials and informational literature was distributed in the community.

VOLUNTEERS

Provided training to 192 volunteers who donated over 5,500 hours of direct victim service (Board members contributed another estimated 800 hours of service).
